Please find below the information we hold. Physiotherapy and Occupational Therapy do not carry a waiting list and all accepted referrals are seen within 13 weeks with an average two weeks.

Speech and Language Service waiting list have children currently waiting 52 weeks for first appointment. The Trust is working hard to resolve this situation created by the Covid-19 pandemic and gaps in the service.
